

Bicycle Security

Bike theft is common throughout the ACT. There have been instances of bike thefts from within NAS common bike storage areas and from unit storage cages. Entry has usually been gained by the perpetrators “tailgating” residents and entering through the garage. Please be alert to this possibility.

Security in NAS is quite robust, with CCTV coverage of the garage entry/exit doors and carpark being a general disincentive to thieves. Doors adjacent to the garage entry have also been strengthened against forced opening.

Bike owners are responsible for the security of their bikes. All residents are urged to lock their bicycles securely and follow the “Lock it or lose it” guidelines provided by the ACT Police. See:

Any suspicious activity in the garage, or actual theft should be reported to the Building Manager with details of a possible time frame so that CCTV can be examined and a report be given to police.
